

StackDX Rollout — PrairieSky Well Data Requirement Sheet

Effective May 1, 2026, PrairieSky Royalty Ltd. requires all well documents listed in the Well Data Requirements Sheet to be submitted through StackDX. Action is required before go-live — whether you're an existing StackDX client or new to the platform.

Security & Data Privacy

The PrairieSky project is shared across multiple Lessees, but each Lessee operates independently and can only see its own documents. Only publicly available well data is visible in the shared project.

You can view documents uploaded by your own company only — even if something is misfiled on a licence you do not operate, it remains protected and invisible to others.
